in the twentieth century and its place in mass culture today in this concluding volume ziolkowski explores the popularity of the juggler of notre dame from the 1930s through the second world war especially in the allied resistance its popularity in the united states was subsequently maintained by figures as diverse as tony curtis and w h auden and although recently the story and medievalism have lost ground the future of both holds promise presented with great clarity and simplicity ziolkowski s work is accessible to the general reader while its many new discoveries will be valuable to academics in such fields and disciplines as medieval studies medievalism philology literary history art history folklore performance studies and reception studies
